Dear Mr. Townsend:

In furtherance of our conversation earlier today (in which you hung up on me), I want to stress that I am in no way impugning your credibility. I have no doubt that your technical staff has told you that there are problems with accessing the information. However, I have found on more than one occasion that seemingly-insurmountable technical problems can be overcome when the technical experts have a chance to talk directly.

Again, I am simply asking that we be allowed to have a brief discussion with the Court's technical staff to better understand the nature of the data retrieval issues. That doesn't seem like much to ask. New Jersey has very open rules with respect to access and public records, and we need to understand whether the Court's unwillingness to provide the data we seek is driven by fundamental corruption of the data, limitations in your data retrieval system, or a policy that the underlying data will not be provided to the public at this time regardless.

I need to hear from you by next Wednesday, January 23 regarding the scheduling of a one-hour call with your technical staff. Otherwise, we will have to pursue legal action to get the information we need. You can reach me at (206) 734-4113 or josh@avvo.com.
