Dear Mr. Townsend:

In response to your letter of December 7 (see correspondence following), we are formally requesting, pursuant to New Jersey Statute 47:1A *et seq*, public records relating to attorney admission in New Jersey. Specifically, we are seeking, for all attorneys licensed in New Jersey:

- Name
- Year of admission to the bar
- Business contact information
- Current bar status (good standing, inactive, etc.)

We understand that the judiciary is in the midst of developing a database of attorney records and cannot provide that database to us. However, we are not requesting the database application – we are requesting the underlying public records data. As we have mentioned before, we are happy to take this data in any reasonable form that is convenient to you, and will of course cover your costs incurred in making it available.
